I confirm receipt of your email and document, thank you

Kindly find attached the application we submitted to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs with the following details, as requested in the letter paragraph 2 :

2.1 : exact dates + sampling areas : May 15th to September 1st 2024 + sampling areas with GPS coordinates paragraph 5 of the application, page 20 - there are additional coordinates which are still to be authorised which are not included in the application form

2.2 : duration of the works : each sampling stations last around 4 hours, Tara realized one station per day (two maximum but exceptionally)

2.3 : fields of research : For two consecutive years, the schooner Tara is participating in the study of coastal ecosystems all along the European coast. The sampling of **Tara Europa is part of the TREC expedition – Traversing European Coastlines**, conceived by EMBL in collaboration with the Tara OceanS consortium, the Tara Ocean Foundation and more than 70 scientific institutions. During this expedition, a parallel study of biodiversity on land, with EMBL's mobile laboratories, and at sea, with the schooner Tara, is carried out. Only surface sampling, no seabed sampling. (paragraph 2 of the application attached, page 2 to 3)

2.4 : technical vessel's characteristics which make it special and necessary : S/V Tara is equipped with scientific instruments and laboratories on board (all of the instruments are detailed in paragraphs 3 and 4 = application attached page 5 to 20)

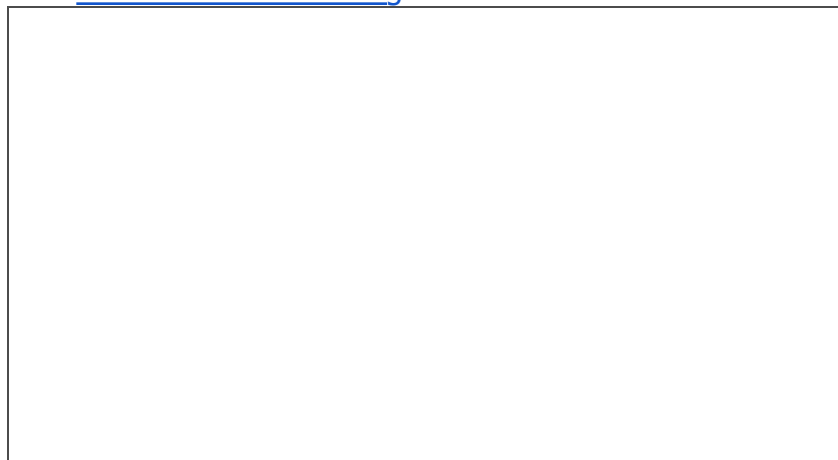
